Itinerary

Friday – 9/24/21

8:00AM - Leave home and drive to Akron.

11:30AM - Lunch at the Lock 15 Brewing Company. Lock 15 Brewing is nestled next to the Cascade Valley Trailhead and the historic Mustill Store Museum along the Ohio & Erie Canal Towpath Trail.

1:00PM – Tour Stan Hywet Hall and Gardens, an exquisite Tudor Revival mansion built in 1912 by the co-founder of Goodyear Tire & Rubber, Frank Seiberling. The estate includes the historic 65-room manor house, a Gothic-Revival Conservatory and approximately 70 acres of artistically landscaped grounds and formal gardens. Tour cost for our group of the home and Gardens is \$ 9.50 per person.

3:00PM - Leave Stan Hywet and drive to the Holiday Inn Express located about one hour away at I-80 and Ohio Route 46 in Austintown Ohio.

10:30AM - Our first stop is a visit to the TP Tools Auto Museum located about five miles away at 7075 State Route 446, Canfield, OH. The museum houses over 50 beautifully restored autos ranging from 1910 to 1970s and newer, all surrounded by nostalgic decor and exhibits that will take you on a journey of days gone by. The interior is decorated with different nostalgic store themes including a replica 50's diner, a 50's soda bar, country stores, a service garage area, a Buick service area, a Lee clothing store and a dentist's office. Photography is encouraged. A wide variety of auto restoration tools and sand blasting equipment can be purchased from the TP Tools store.

(The museum doesn't open to the general public until 1:00PM). The National Packard Museum is a 23,000 square foot complex that houses a rotating display of original and restored Packard automobiles as well as original documents, photographs, artifacts, and interpretive materials that chronicle the illustrious history of the Packard family, the Packard Motor Car Company, and the Packard Electric Company. Plan to spend about two hours at the museum.
