### **The Age of Steam Roundhouse Museum**

**Tour: 1:00pm** (Please Arrive by 12:45pm. It's a 35-minute drive from our hotel.)

The Age of Steam Roundhouse Museum is more than just a museum and collection. It is a living, breathing roundhouse where talented restoration specialists work to preserve the more than 26 locomotives, railroad cars, tools, and machinery from the glory days of railroading.

Needing a place to safely store and restore his fleet of vintage railroad equipment, founder Jerry Jacobson acquired 34 acres of farmland near Sugarcreek, Ohio. The site consists of storage tracks, a store house, coal dock, wood water tank, ash pit, back shop and the jewel of the site, a complete, working, 18-stall, brick roundhouse surrounding a 115-foot turntable. It is the first full-sized, working roundhouse built in the U.S. since 1951.

The tour lasts 1.5 hours. The \$18.00 admission price is reduced to \$15.00 if we have 20 or more participants.


### **Triple Locks Park**
