This event was originally scheduled for July 24, but that date was unavailable at GE. The revised date, August 1, is a **SATURDAY**. Please note that this is still considered our **JULY** activity, as the upcoming overnight trip to Dearborn remains our official AUGUST outing.

The GE Aerospace Visitor's Center is not normally open to the public, so this will be a rare opportunity to get an inside look at the technology of one of Cincinnati's leading corporations. The visitor's center serves as a showcase for GE's aviation heritage as well as a remarkable display of current technology and twenty-first century commercial and military aviation leadership. Within the modern two-story facility, giant compressor engine blades sweep toward the sky above while, underneath, visitors enter the engine display area. OVEB member, Jim Arlinghaus, will serve as our tour guide. He is personally familiar with many of the jet engines on display, having installed international trade show exhibits for GE Aerospace prior to his retirement.

If you are coming from the north, take I-75 South to the Glendale-Milford exit and stay straight, cross I-75 and then turn right into the GE parking lot. If you are coming from the South, take I-75N to the Shepard Lane exit and then go straight until you get to the GE parking lot.

Century Inn Restaurant

The Century Inn was built in 1806 as one of the first carriage stops in Hamilton County and has remained in continuous operation ever since. The current owner, Greg Ready, purchased the Inn in 2012 and met his wife Dee at the restaurant in 2013. Greg considers it a pleasure and a privilege to offer great food, a welcoming atmosphere, and a piece of Ohio's historic past to his guests. The Inn is highly regarded for their generous portions of meatloaf, hand-battered fish and chips, and what many locals consider some of the best fried chicken in the area. Driving Directions from GE Aerospace Learning Center to the Century Inn

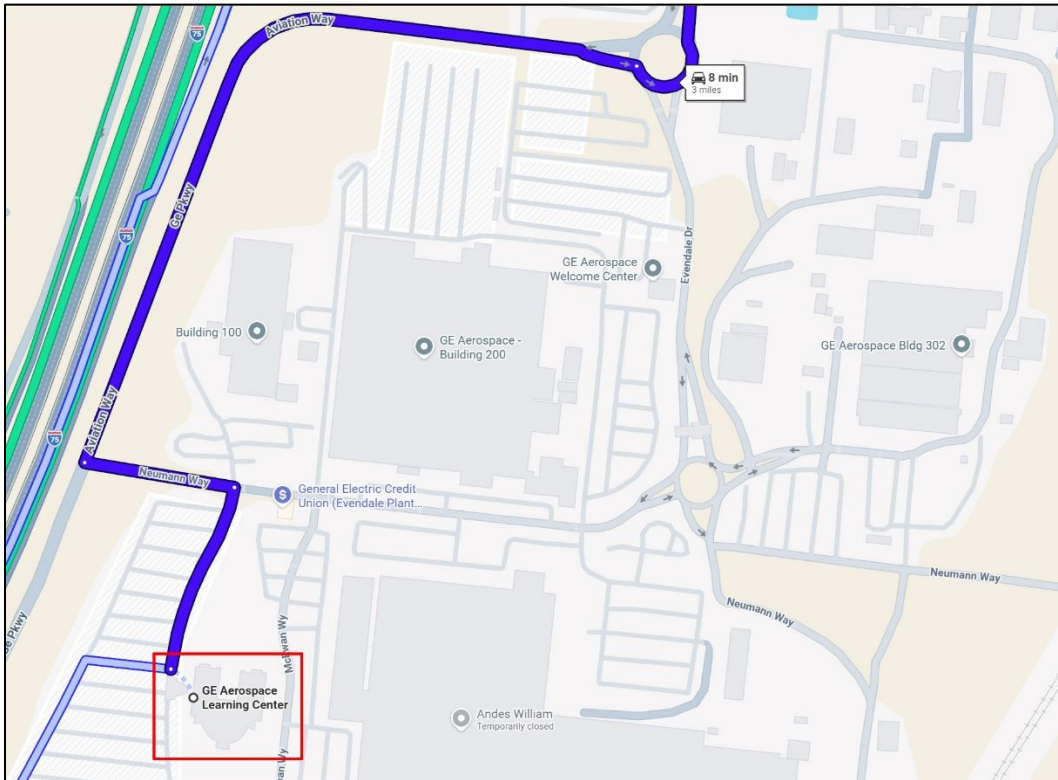
From the GE Aerospace Learning Center

- Exit the parking lot toward Neumann Way - 489 ft
- Turn left onto Neumann Way - 384 ft
- Turn right onto Aviation Way/GE Pkwy - 0.4 mi
- At the traffic circle, turn left onto Aviation Way - 0.2 mi
- At the next traffic circle, take the 2nd exit and stay on Aviation Way - 0.2 mi
- Use the left 2 lanes to turn left onto Glendale Milford Rd - 1.6 mi
- Use the right 2 lanes to turn right onto Springfield Pike
- The destination will be on the left – 0.5 Mi
