We'll meet at the Tri-State Warbird Museum at the Clermont County Airport in Batavia, OH at 10:00am. The admission fee is \$7 per person, which is discounted from the regular price.

The museum was founded in 2003 to preserve the aircraft of World War II, to educate visitors on America's role in WWII, and to honor the veterans who fought and those who made the ultimate sacrifice. We'll receive a guided tour of the beautifully restored World War II airplanes in the museum's collection: a B-25 Mitchell bomber "Axis Nightmare/Yankee Doodle", a P-51 Mustang fighter "Cincinnati Miss", an AT-6 Texan advanced trainer "Tweety", a Stearman primary trainer and more.

We'll depart the museum at 11:30am and drive 5.7 miles (about 13 minutes) to our lunch destination—the Red Lobster restaurant on Ohio Pike (Route 125). Please refer to the driving directions and map on the last page.





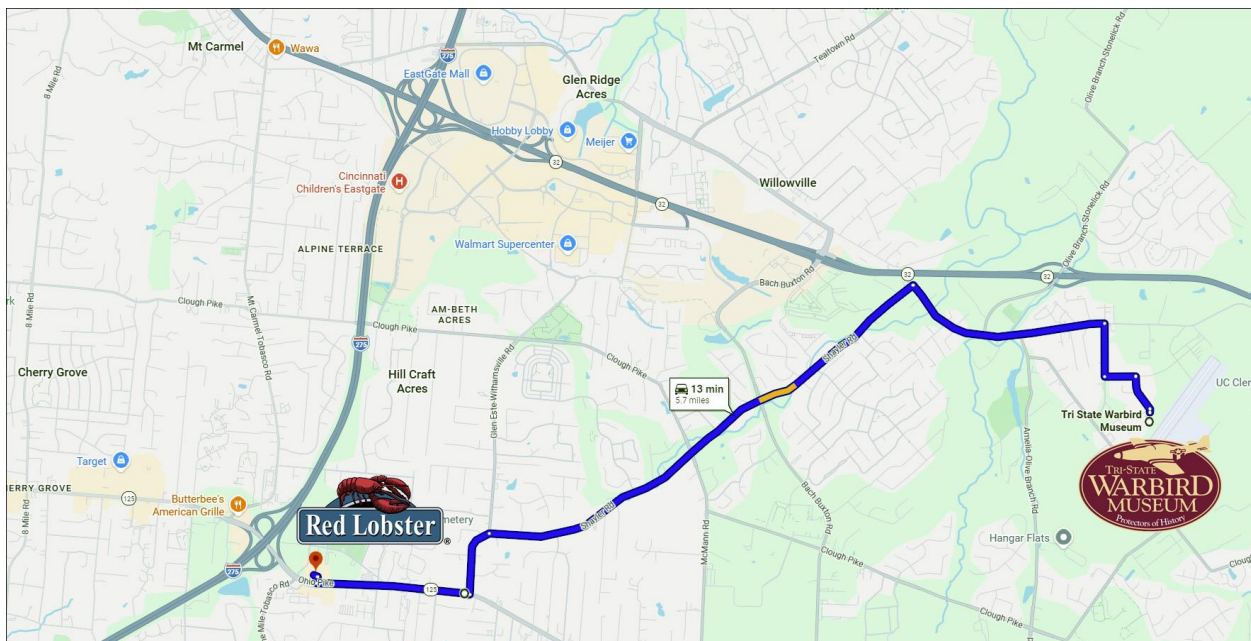

Driving Directions from Tri-State Warbird Museum to Red Lobster on Ohio Pike



Depart Tri State Warbird Museum

4021 Borman Dr, Batavia, OH 45103

- Head toward Borman Dr (92 ft)
- Continue onto Borman Dr (0.2 mi)
- Turn left onto Glenn Pkwy (0.2 mi)
- Turn right onto Armstrong Blvd (0.3 mi)
- Turn left onto Cincinnati-Batavia Pike/Old State Rte 74 (1.1 mi)
- Turn left onto Shayler Rd (2.7 mi)

- Continue (Veer Left) onto Glen Este-Withamsville Rd (0.4 mi)
- Turn right onto OH-125 W/Ohio Pike (0.8 mi)
- Turn right into Red Lobster driveway (180 ft)
- Turn left into restaurant parking lot (108 ft)
