


Ohio Valley Early Birds Featured in Current Early Bird Magazine

Welcome to OVEB NEWS – The 2020 Version

As I mentioned earlier, Bill Curtis suggested last year that he thought we should bring back the OVEB newsletter. I agreed that it was a worthwhile idea, but I questioned whether we could find anyone to produce it. I do have some experience with this subject.

When I first became club president in 2012, I had this crazy idea of publishing an OVEB newsletter. I wrote the copy, shot the photos, created the layout, printed the pages and mailed them to every member each month. People seemed to enjoy reading it, but it was an unsustainable effort for one person. The cost of printer ink and postage was also a significant expense. I gave up after two years, because by that time, we





had a fully functioning website which offered much of the same content.

I was hoping that our members would use the OVEB website as their official source for club news and photos. Some of you regularly visit oveb.org. It has also become a great recruiting tool for the club. Over the years, Bill has continued to upgrade the site with additional features and content. Most recently, he performed a major update which enhances viewing the site on a mobile phone or tablet. He also added a password protected members-only section

where you can download the club roster and view meeting minutes and other proprietary documents.

When Bill raised the subject of resurrecting **OVEB NEWS**, we both agreed that the old publishing model would have to go. Instead, we've adopted some new rules:

We're not going to print the newsletters and mail them to members. We will email them to you as colorful PDF documents that you can view on your computer monitor, or, if you prefer, print out at home. This saves trees, ink and postage.

OVEB NEWS will be a focused publication. Each month, we'll include information about an upcoming event and reflect on the previous month's club activity. We'll show some event photos, but we won't include *all* the photos. Instead, we'll include a link to the website where you can view additional images. We'll include information about upcoming member birthdays and always include a copy of our complete event calendar. Additional space can be devoted to a variety of subjects such as historical information, human interest stories or technical articles.

Lacking an official newsletter editor, this will have to be a *collaborative* effort. Bill Curtis got the ball rolling by creating a sample template based on our past newsletters and current newsletters from other CTCI chapters. For the time being, he will handle the layout of each issue and create the PDF files. I will assist with content creation, but we need YOUR help.

If you have photos to include that will be helpful. It doesn't have to be fancy; it just needs to be timely. We'll massage the copy to fit the format.

Do you have an interesting story to share? Remember the "guess who did this" game we played at the Christmas party? Our members would love to read about your experiences, especially if they involve a T-Bird. Tell us about it and include photos if you can.

Do you have any technical tips to share? Did you finally figure out why your car wouldn't start when it was hot? Tell us about it. Have you learned any tricks over the years that make it easier to maintain your T-Bird? Have you performed any modifications on your car that make it safer to drive? Other members can benefit from your experience.

If you or any family members are experiencing health issues and you would like to share the information with your fellow club members, please let us know. Likewise, if you are about to celebrate any of life's milestones, we'd love to hear from you.

Finally, if you would like to volunteer to be our official newsletter editor, we'd love to have you. Your fellow club members would appreciate it. \bigcirc
